



Army Unveils New Weapon Code Name: "Pinwheel of Death"



Pictured above is the 60th regt., "GO DEVILS" illustrating the latest advance in combining weaponry and tactics, as well as infantry and the air corps. – code name "The Pinwheel of Death". Four man teams will parachute in unison underneath one large canopy/chute, with rifles blazing as they descend. The recoil of the rifles will spin the squad in a circular motion creating a Gatling gun on a horizontal and vertical axis. Those squads lucky enough to have a Thompson will be able to hover in mid-air until all clips are expended before safely floating to the earth.

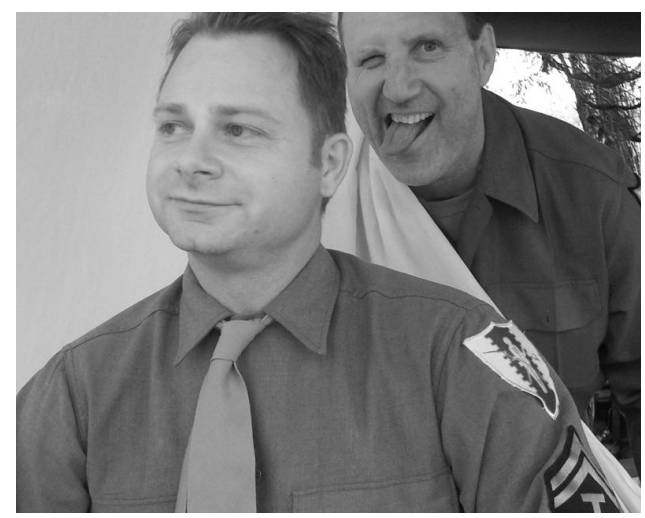
